No food will be available on the grounds. There are convenience stores on Route 100 near Morrisville and also towards Stowe. There are super markets in Morrisville and Stowe.


#### **Please Note**

This licensed test will be held in accordance with NAHRA's test regulations and procedures. For NAHRA's Field Test Rules and Procedures and Code of Conduct, please go to <a href="https://www.nahra.org">www.nahra.org</a>

NO VERBAL OR PHYSICAL ABUSE of the judges, workers, or dogs will be tolerated. Everyone is expected to be polite and congenial at all times; other behavior will be cause for removal from the test grounds. LCRC policy prohibits consumption of alcoholic beverages until the conclusion of the day's testing. To be respectful of the judges and workers, testing will stop no later than 6 p.m. Saturday so everyone may enjoy our tailgate party! Please plan on staying in the area over night.

Directions to Test Headquarters (see map below)

From Interstate I-89, take Exit 10 (Waterbury/Route 100). Follow Route 100 north toward Stowe and Morrisville. In Stowe, continue 5.7 miles on Route 100 past junction with Route 108 (1). Just past the Ryder Brook Golf Club on the left, turn right onto Goeltz Road (2). Go 1.1 miles, cross intersection with Randolph Road (3) and continue about 0.4 mile on Bliss Hill Road. Watch for LCRC sign on the left (4).
